Dr. B. G. Parasuramalu did his MBBS from Bangalore Medical College, Bangalore (1980) and MD (Community Medicine) from Karnataka Medical College, Hubli (1983). He joined KIMS, Bengaluru on 27/03/86 as Assistant Professor and became Professor and HOD on 01/08/2005 till his retirement on 31/01/14 after serving for 28 years. He was actively involved in under graduate and postgraduate teaching. He has guided 9 Post Graduate students.

Dr. B. G. Parasuramalu was responsible for starting of the Allergy Clinic in the KIMSH & RC in 1990. Conducting “Allergy test” namely prick test and patch test for Allergic Rhinitis & Bronchial Asthma patients & prescribing Immunotherapy for them. He was responsible for therapies like RUSH Immunotherapy and sub lingual Immunotherapy.

Dr. B. G. Parasuramalu is a Fellow of Indian Society for Communicable Disease [F.I.S.C.D]. Awarded the B M Patil Memorial Oration Award of 2009 by Karnataka Association of Community Health. Awarded the Fellowship of Indian Academy of Allergy in 2011. He was the Treasurer for “Indian Academy of Allergy”.
