World Health Day-2009:

Amirtha Varsheni M,Aishwarya B,Shwetha S, & Mona Ufra Shaik of 6th term made presentations on the world health day theme 2009 – Safe Lives, Make Hospitals safe in Emergencies on 12th April, 2009. About 90 students from 6th term participated. The staff of the department of Community Medicine were present. The presentation was followed by discussion on the subject & distribution of certificates to the students .

<u>Investigation of an outbreak of GE in Bangalore</u> city,May 2009:

The department of Community Medicine was involved in the investigation of an outbreak of cholera in Bangalore city during the month of May 2009. The postgraduates of the department under the guidance of Dr. B G Parasuramalu conducted the investigation. A report was prepared and submitted. The study was also presented as a paper in the KACH Conference.

<u>Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU),</u> New Delhi:

The 14th batch of IGNOU students in the Post Graduate Diploma in Maternal & Child Health completed the course conducted during the year. About 33 students had enrolled for the course including 15 doctors posted from the government sector.

<u>Training of Trainers (TOT) programme - Intra Dermal Rabies Vaccination (IDRV) & RIG administration:</u>

A TOT programme for state government doctors on IDRV & RIG administration was conducted at the Preventive Medicine Unit, Anti Rabies Clinic, KIMS Hospital & Research Centre, Bangalore-4 from 20th-27th June, 2009 in three batches. About 58 doctors were trained during the programme.

<u>Screening for H1N1 at Bangalore International</u> <u>Airport:</u>

The staff, postgraduate students of community medicine and interns conducted the screening for H1N1 disease of the International passengers from 1st September, 2009 to 15th September, 2009 at the Bangalore International Airport, Bangalore. About 20,000 passengers were screened during this period.

Adopt a village –Rabies prevention project :

The Global Alliance for Rabies Control (GARC), Rabies in Asia Foundation (RIAF), Commonwealth Veterinary Association (CVA), the Department of Community Medicine, Kempegowda Institute of Medical Sciences, Bangalore, Government Veterinary College, Hebbal,Bangalore and the Department of Neurovirology, NIMHANS, Bangalore have come together for a novel rural rabies prevention project. The project is for a period of 2 years and was started on 1st December 2009 and will conclude by 31st November 2011. The aim of the project is to the reduce the incidence of both human and animal rabies in the rural community.

Intensified Pulse Polio Immunization Programme (IPPI) NID rounds of 2010:

The students of KIMS (4th, term) & staff of the community medicine department were actively involved in the NID rounds of IPPI on 10th January,2010 & 7th February 2010. This is the fifteenth successive year of participation by the department for the eradication of polio since the inception of the programme in 1995.

CME on Rabies for Interns:

A CME on rabies for interns was organized by the department of community medicine on 17th February,2010 at KIMSH&RC,Bangalore-4.About 30 interns had participated. The CME concluded with interactive discussion on the various aspects of prevention and control of rabies.

Workshop on Intra dermal rabies vaccination (IDRV) for BBMP Medical, health and veterinary staff:

A one day workshop on IDRV for BBMP Medical, health and veterinary staff was held on 22nd March, 2010 at KIMS College, Banashanakari –II stage, Bangalore –70 .About 96 hospital staff from BBMP were trained in the newer concepts of IDRV.
