VISIT TO MILK DAIRY

16 May 2023

RABIES PRE EXPOSURE VACCINATION FOR ANIMAL HANDLERS AT BANNERGHATTA NATIONAL PARK, BANGALORE

May - October 2023

The Staff, Post Graduates and Interns from the department were involved in Rabies pre-exposure (PrEP) vaccination of animal handlers at the Bannerghatta National Park, Bangalore. This year the team visited after a gap of 5 years due to disruption caused by the COVID 19 pandemic.

About 250 members, who included the employees of the National park and their family members were vaccinated. About 100 members were vaccinated with first dose. This was followed by visits on the 7th (2nd dose) day and 28th day (3rd dose) respectively to complete the pre-exposure prophylaxis for the newly vaccinated individuals.
